**We would also like to let you know what steps we have taken:**

**A main perpetrator has been arrested.**

**We have undertaken plain clothed operations.**

**We have built strong links with the housing associations to help deal with anti-social behaviour.**

**We are compiling evidence on frequent offenders to work towards ASBOs.**
