Meeting for children aged 8 - 11, **Each child must come with one of their parents.**

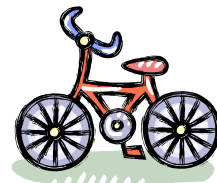
Vital to the success of the project is having people to help in running the youth clubs. Training for possible volunteers will take place on
