



Inspiring young engineers of the future

Out-of-school clubs aimed at 9-12 year olds, meeting for an hour a week where children are introduced to engineering and technology and have fun making a series of working models from simple kits that they can take home when completed.

For schools, educationalists and parents

- children gain experience, motivation, confidence and a range of skills, enriching the curriculum
- mix learning with practical activity; additional opportunities for achievement and growth
- direct involvement with engineers and links with modern industry including factory visits

For engineers

Most existing clubs, typically 12 children, are run by volunteer engineer tutors with teachers and parent helpers. In order to give more children the benefits of the experience we have developed Clubs led by teachers/teaching assistants after appropriate training (and with a guide engineer in support).

Imagineering also offers more advanced kits through Inter-Engineering, aimed at children of early secondary school age who have taken part in the junior Clubs. We are also able to organise a limited number of summer schools.

Imagineering Clubs are organised by the Imagineering Foundation, an educational charity based on a network of engineers. They are highly successful with numbers increasing over 5 times between 2002 and 2008. Imagineering has also been awarded the Learning Grid Quality Standard for its work in the Clubs.

In widening the network of clubs we collaborate with other educational organisations such as SETPoints, Learning Grid, LEAs and Young Engineers and Engineering Development Trust.
